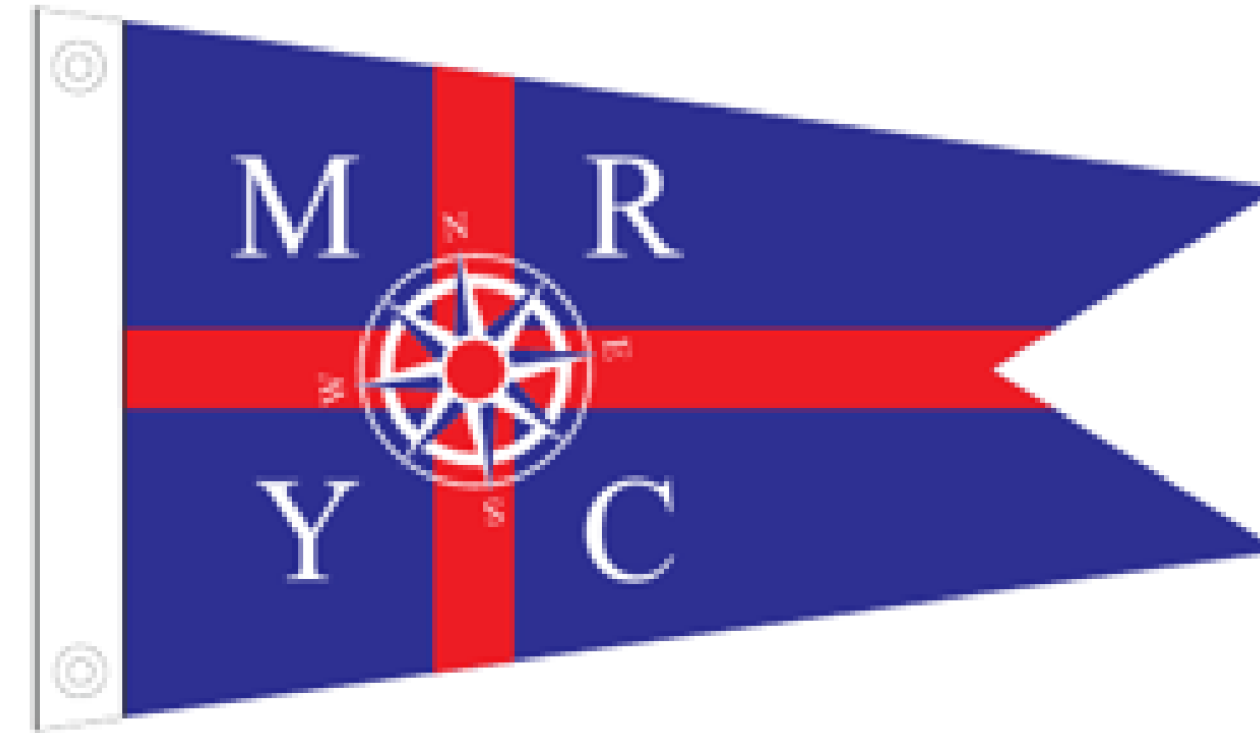

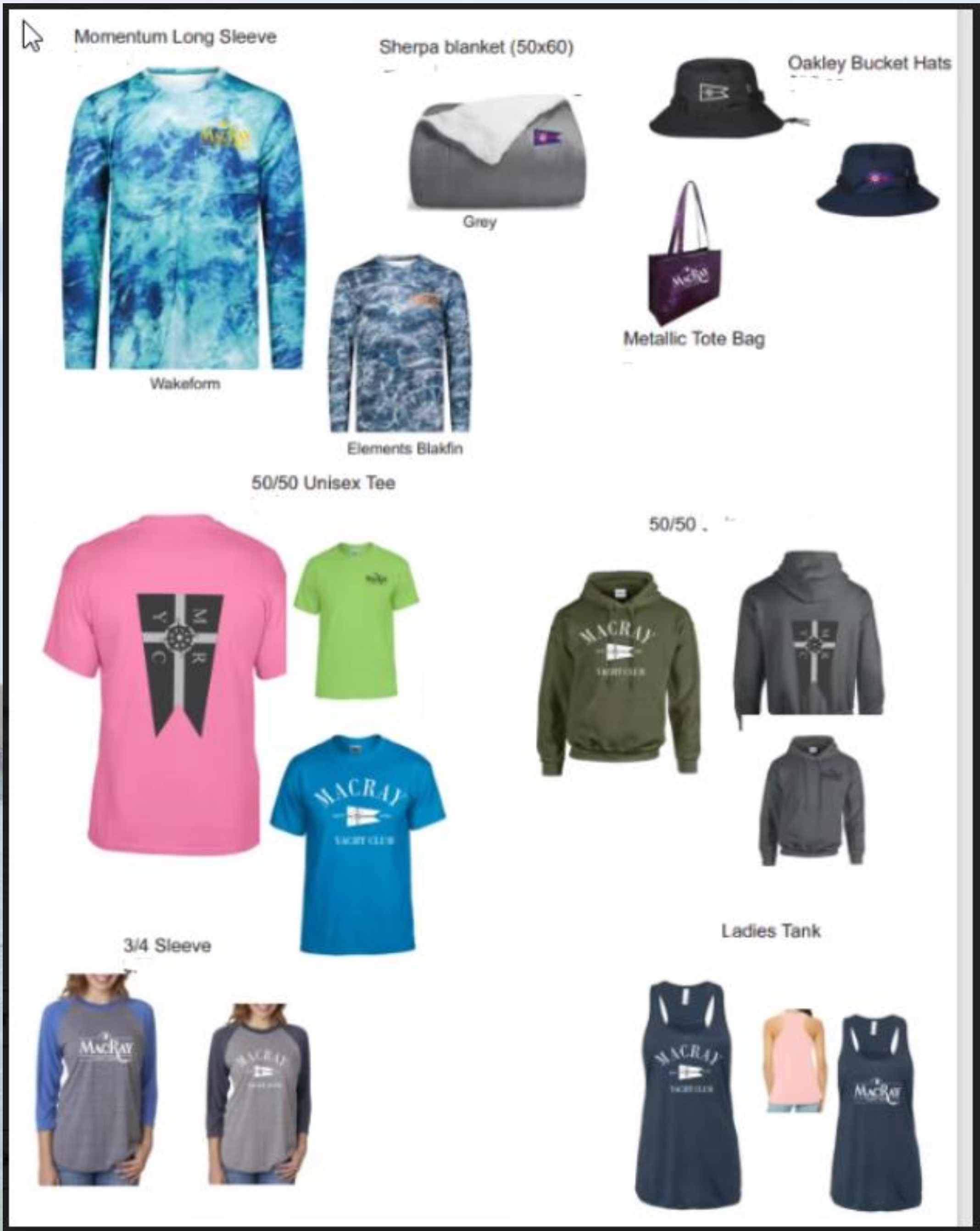

A word about Entering Canada.....

MUST HAVES for entry to Canada and return to USA

- Passport or enhanced driver's license
- DTOP Transponder decal (any boat over 30') for reentry to US
- <https://dtops.cbp.dhs.gov/main/login.htm#%20> Cost \$33
- NO FIREARMS

Returning to the USA

- Call US Customs Boarder Patrol CBP - When entering the US
- The master of the boat must report to CBP telephonically and be directed to the nearest Port of Entry to satisfy the face-to-face requirement, or report to the nearest designated reporting location along with the boat's passengers for inspection.

Considerations for Pets

- 8 months or older need updated shots including rabies
- 8 months or younger - also need a health certificate

Learn this phrase regarding alcohol on boat – NORMAL BAR STOCK

A word about Entering Canada.....

Canada/USA - Optional to make it EASIER

- Nexus Card \$50 fee. Apply online at <https://www.cbp.gov/travel/trusted-traveler-programs/nexus> Virtual or In-person interview req'd

Exceptions to Face-to-Face reporting to CBP

- Alternative Inspection Systems (AIS) satisfy the boat operator's legal requirement to report for face-to-face inspection in accordance with 8 CFR 235.1, but boaters must still phone in their arrival to satisfy 19 USC 1433.
- There are three exceptions to the face-to-face inspection at a designated reporting location, **CBP Reporting Offsite Arrival – Mobile (CBP ROAM)**, NEXUS, and the Canadian Border Boat Landing Permit (I-68). Participation in any of these programs does not preclude the requirement for physical report upon request by U.S. Customs and Border Protection.
- In the app - request verified travelers which will get you the BR numbers that you enter into the app so that you just report your arrival

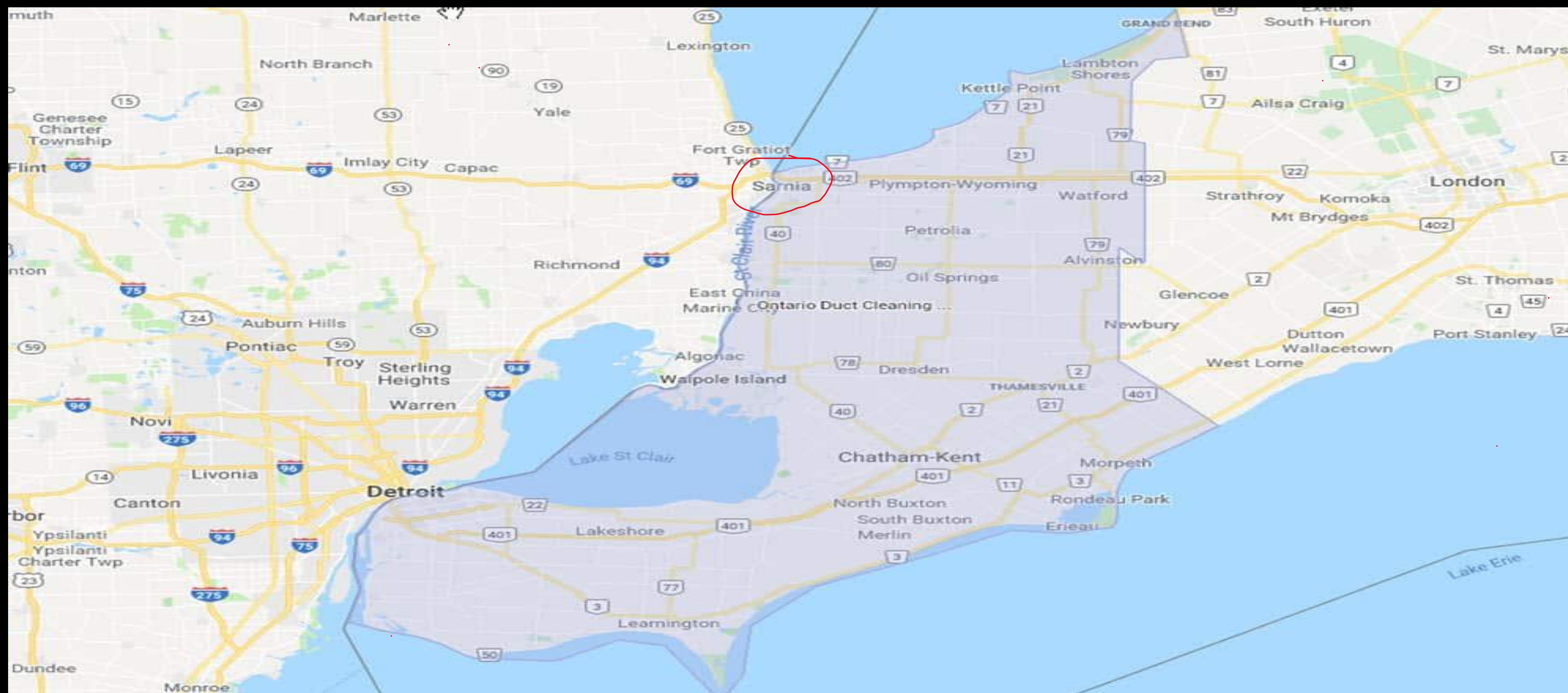
